# Reactor in a Ring of Fire: Indonesia's nuclear power plans

Guest speakers:

Professor Richard Tanter: Director, Nautilus Institute, RMIT University  
Ms Arabella Imhoff: Researcher, Nautilus Institute

The Indonesian Government's proposal to build a large nuclear power plant on the Muria peninsula, on the north coast of Central Java, faces substantial community opposition. The reactor site is near the base of volcanic Mt Muria, in an earthquake zone. A major accident would contaminate Java, the world's most densely populated island; and fall-out could spread as far as central Australia.

Richard Tanter and Arabella Imhoff have visited the site recently, and written extensively on this risky proposal. Their presentation will be a chance to hear the extraordinary story of the reactor, the community campaign against it; and the forces in Indonesia and our region who are supporting it.
