New Clear Exchange nuclear weapons workshops were successfully run around Australia in February 2010, inspiring participants with a dynamic mix of information and discussion on nuclear weapons abolition.

ICAN — the **International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons** — is offering one final Melbourne workshop, supported by the **Medical Association for Prevention of War**, on 1 May, just two days before the key month-long **nuclear Non Proliferation Treaty Review Conference** begins in New York.

The workshop is targeted towards members of peace, environment, aid and development organisations; church groups; unions; and international studies students and academics, as well as those already involved in nuclear issues in Australia and globally. It aims to build expertise and understanding of these crucial current issues, as well as developing concrete campaign ideas. All participants are invited to share their views on the issues around nuclear weapons and interconnections to other local campaign areas. Feedback from the workshops has been very positive, with many additional activities being initiated by participants.

ICAN Campaign Director **Dimity Hawkins** will lead the workshop. The workshop is free of charge.
